

Gubernatorial Decree #005

A DECREE

to

review the citizenry of New South Scotland.

BE IT ENACTED by His Imperial Majesty Emperor Jonathan I through the Office of Governing Commissioner, as stated:

I) Audit of the citizenship records

- 1) In view of the 2020-2024 period of inactivity, it is hereby decreed that the Commission of Demography (henceforth 'the Commission) shall undertake a *Review into the Activity of the New South Scottish Citizenry* (henceforth 'the Review') per Section 3.9.1 of the Constitution. The Commission shall finalise the Review no later than 1700hrs EAST 30 April 2024.
- 2) The Review shall consider whether New South Scottish citizens have engaged, in any formal capacity, with the Office of the Governing Commissioner (henceforth 'the Office') since 2020.
- 3) Upon finalisation of the Review, citizens who have not been found to have engaged with the Office in this manner shall have their citizenship permanently suspended per Section 3.9.3 of the Constitution.
- 4) The results of the Review shall be promulgated by the Commission of Demography in lieu of individually informing former citizens of their citizenship suspension.

II) Definitions, extent and commencement

- 1) This Decree shall take effect in all of New South Scotland.
- 2) This Decree shall be known in common form as the 'Gubernatorial Decree for the Review of the Citizenry of New South Scotland 2024'.
- 3) This Decree shall also be known in code as 24-GD-005.
- 4) This Decree shall take effect immediately.
